UPDATE ON THE BREED NAME CHANGE

The process for the Breed Name Change grinds on with success. The following is the latest from the Canadian Kennel Club:

“Over the course of the next year the Legislation Committee will be considering proposed amendments to CKC By-laws and in June 2011 a package of recommendations will be presented for the Board's approval. This package will include a request to seek the permission of the membership to amend the Articles of Incorporation and Section 25.1 of the By-laws (List of Recognized Breeds) to amend the name of

Welsh Corgi (Cardigan) to the Cardigan Welsh Corgi.

In order to change the name of a breed the Club must make an application to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada to amend our Articles of Incorporation. In order to be successful 25% or more of our voting members must respond to the Referendum and at least two thirds of those members must be in favour of changing the name.”

And as well, he has been busy updating it when the summer's news has been sent to him. Huge thanks to Ron. The second issue of Cardigan Happenings came out in March reformatted in Microsoft Publisher thanks to Maja's hard work. The next issue will be early October and a request for articles will be sent to the membership in a few days.

One thing the Publications Committee would like to hear from the Executive is about whether all back issues of the Newsletter should be scanned to PDFs and placed on the web site. And or selected articles could be included in the Cardigan Happenings either in their entirety or in part.

Events (Gloria Graham, Chair)

This year has seen four significant events hosted by the CCCC.

1. The first were the annual herding trials May long weekend in Hope, BC. Because the specialty was held in Alberta the following month these trials were the BC/Northern Regional Trials for the CCCC.
2. The second event was the Specialty in Edmonton.
3. The third event was the clinic/trials held near High River, Alberta the week and weekend following the specialty. We held an actual specialty trial on the Friday for Cardigans only. We had 7 entries in that trial

but unfortunately it wasn't the Cardigans' day. No one qualified. The following two days were all breed trials.

4. The fourth event was more herding trials put on by a group of our members in Utopia, Ontario. This was their first experience hosting trials and by all accounts they did a great job.

Status Report Update

Versatility Title (Sandi & Al): At this time 2 proposals have been developed and have been circulated to the board for feedback. A variety of opinions have been received, often conflicting. We will continue to work with that information to format a proposal that can be circulated to the membership.

Trophy & Awards (Sandi & Anne): We reported in the April 2010 Cardigan Happenings on three of the dogs for which the conformation trophies are named. There are 13 trophies for Conformation, and in future Cardigan Happenings, we will try to feature more of the dogs. There are at least 10 other trophies available for obedience, agility and herding as well as special dogs. During the winter, we will try to clarify more about those trophies including their history and when and why they have been awarded.
